## ISLE OF WIGHT LOCAL REQUIREMENTS (In addition to National Requirements) August 2020

Where information is not required in order to validate a planning application, the planning authority may subsequently request additional information to justify the proposals against planning policies or to determine impacts, depending on the specifics of an application, the site and its potential impacts.

Any plans or drawings must be drawn to an identified metric scale (showing a scale bar/ruler) and in the case of location and block plans, must show the direction of north.

For all planning proposals relating to householder development, plans should be submitted at a size no greater than A3.

Any applications for non-material minor amendments to an approved development should include information in the form of a covering letter, email or annotations on the plans, listing the proposed changes to the approved scheme.
