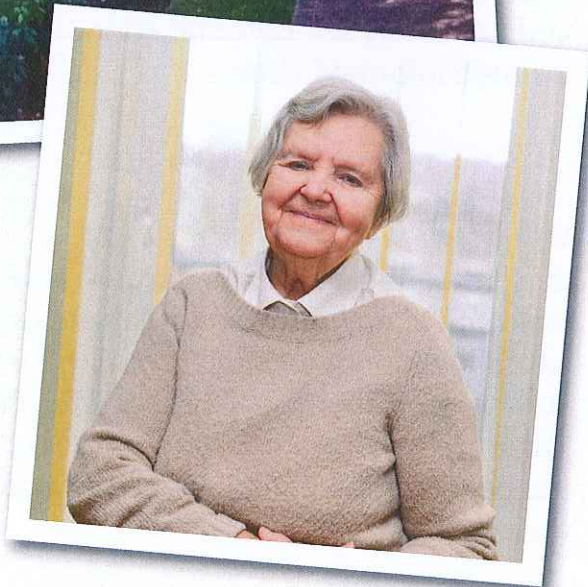
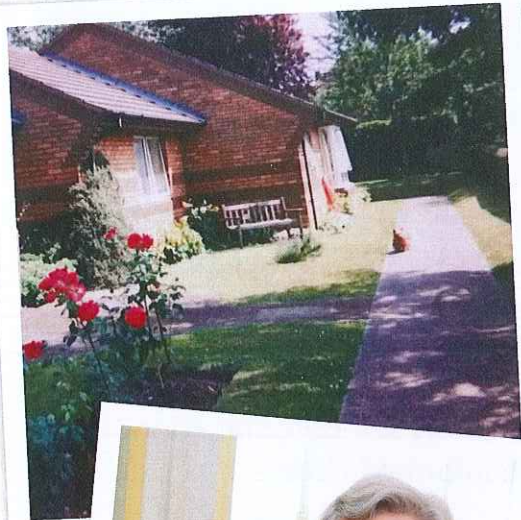


## Services

Providing day care, convalescence, respite, rehabilitation and short stays.

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The Adelaide has a long standing reputation for the high quality of care it provides for its clients who have a wide variety of needs.

## Aims and objectives

To enhance quality of life by providing a safe, secure and comfortable environment, supported by our highly trained care team, allowing for a maximum of personal choice and minimum restriction with the need for privacy and dignity given great importance.

To enable clients and their carers to maintain and promote their independence and quality of life by providing day care, bathing clinics, short-stays, respite and rehabilitation.

To work closely with health and social care professionals who will visit on a regular basis or will make visits by arrangement. These include local GP and district nurse.

To provide all staff with the opportunity to access training and supervision required to fulfil the above aims and objectives.

## Facilities

The Adelaide provides services and support 24 hours a day seven days a week throughout the year. It has 22 single and 2 double rooms spread over 2 floors which are accessible by both stairs and a large passenger lift.

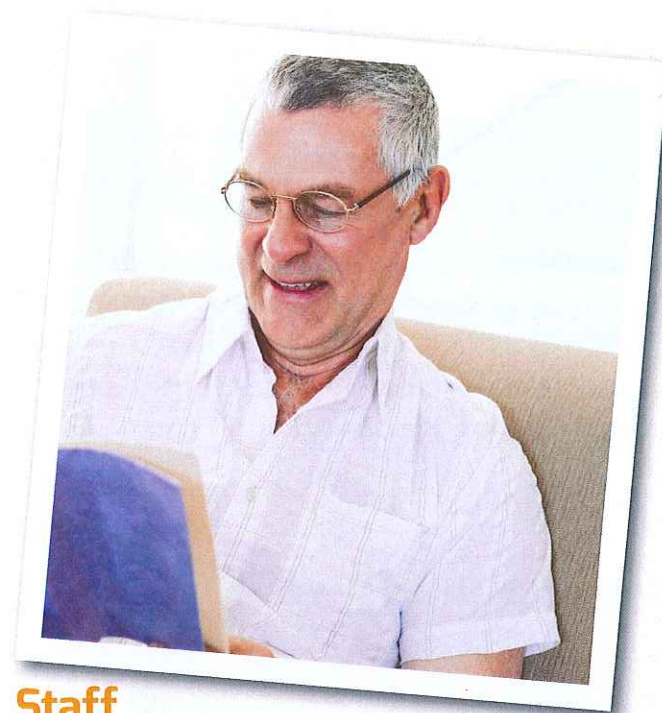
Respite care can be regular or short-term, ranging from an overnight stay to longer periods.

Appetizing nutritionally balanced meals are provided. These are freshly prepared and cooked on site daily and reflects each individual's likes, dislikes and dietary needs.

There are a wide range of stimulating leisure activities including, outings, seasonal events, daily indoor entertainment and the occasional party.

The Adelaide also has a shop which offers a range of toiletries, confectionery and other useful items which is run by volunteers.

The Adelaide also offers personal services which include bathing, chiropody and even an on-site hairdresser.
