Arrangements for Review

EHC Plans should be used to actively monitor a child/young person's progress towards meeting their outcomes and longer term aspirations. Reviews **must** focus on the child or young person's progress towards achieving the outcomes specified in the Plan. Arrangements for reviewing this plan will be co-ordinated by the educational setting.

For children aged under five, the review process will take place once every three to six months to ensure that the provision continues to be appropriate such reviews would complement the duty to carry out a review at least annually but may be streamlined and not necessarily require the attendance of the full range of professionals, depending on the needs of the child.

For children aged five and over, the first review **must** take place within 12 months of the date the Plan was issued and then within 12 months of any previous review.
