Adoption Statement for the Isle of Wight Council Fishbourne Parish Supplementary Planning Document

- 1. This Adoption Statement has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012.
- 2. The Fishbourne Parish Supplementary Planning Document was adopted by the Isle of Wight Council at its Executive meeting on Tuesday 5 August 2014. Following that decision being published and a 5 working day 'call in' period for the decision (as required by the council's Constitution), the SPD came into force on Thursday 14 August 2014.
- 3. The Fishbourne Parish Supplementary Planning Document has been adopted by the council following a request from Fishbourne Parish Council. The Fishbourne Parish Supplementary Planning Document sets out locally important issues and how the parish council would like to see its community in the future, in advance of the Ryde Plan being adopted.
- The adopted Fishbourne Parish Supplementary Planning Document, this Adoption Statement, and the accompanying Consultation Statement, the SA/SEA Screening Statement and Equalities Impact Assessment are all available to view on the council's website and at Planning Reception, Seaclose Offices, Fairlee Road, Newport, Isle of Wight, PO30 2QS within office hours (Monday Thursday 08:30 17:00, Friday 08:00 16:30).

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision. Any such application must be made promptly in any event no later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
