If at any time during this process you suspect or find that a child is suffering, or is likely to suffer from significant harm, STOP and contact Hants Direct on 0300 300 0901

Additional needs or concerns regarding a child/ young person identified that cannot be met by a single agency approach. If EH already in place Needs or concerns discussed with parents/carers. and appropriate child/young person and consent gained to contact contact author of EHA Hants Direct. or Lead Professional Contact Hants Direct on tel no: 0300 300 0901 to check if Early Help Assessment already in place and if not would it be an appropriate assessment. Complete Early Help Assessment and DTT with parents/ carers and child/ young person. Send a copy of signed Assessment and DTT to EH Coordinator, Floor 3, County Hall, Newport, IW. PO30 1UD or by email to earlyhelp@iow.gov.uk with a scanned copy of signed consent. N.B Assessments will not be accepted without consent Convene a Team Around the Family (TAF) meeting within 1 month of completing EHA. At the TAF confirm the Lead Professional and complete Early Help Action Plan/Review. Send copy to EH Coordinator and all TAF members including parents/ carers and young person. Set review date within 3 months. Continue to review action plan and DTT at TAF meetings at least every 3 months, until all needs are met. Send copy to EH Coordinator and all TAF members including parents/ carers and young person. When needs are met, complete closure form and send copy to EH Coordinator
