A. Ella - there is changes happening, they are changing from plastic bags for loose veg/fruit to paper or reusable bag.

Holly advised there was a story recently where Sainsburys switched to vacuum packed mince to reduce packaging and received thousands of complaints because people didn't like it - so there's possibly a long way to go with consumers as well as supermarkets.
