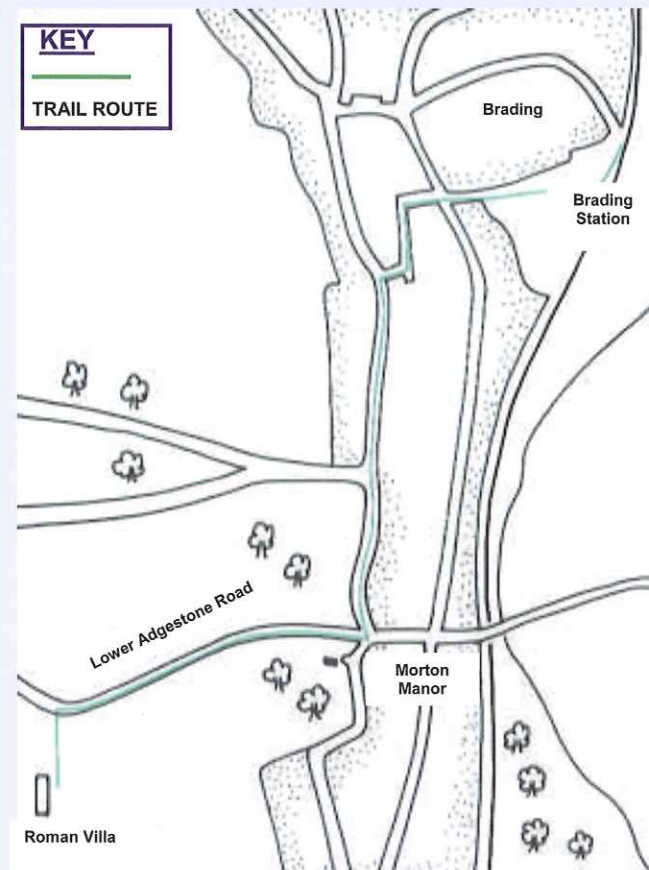

WALK FOUR

Leave Brading Station through the exit gate and cross the car park towards the brown footpath sign "3, 4 and 5", on the left. Follow the footpath to the 'T' junction; turn right and walk up to the main road. Cross over the road and walk up Wrax Road (an unmade road) opposite. Upon reaching 'The Mall' road, turn left up the hill. Continue along this road and take the second turning on your right along Lower Adgestone Road (next to Morton Manor Road). Ignoring Road Signs to the villa, walk up the narrow lane, passing by 'The Lodge' on your left and continue up the hill until you come to a collection of houses. On the left opposite these houses are some steps which will lead you down a footpath to the Brading Roman Villa Visitors Centre. At this point it is possible to retrace your steps.

The building you see today was erected in 2003-4 to protect the remains of the Roman Villa with its mosaics of international importance. From this point good views across Sandown Bay and the Eastern Yar valley can be seen to the south.

The walk should take about an hour.
