2.	Transition Relating to Children
	 School leaders and staff from All Saints, Yarmouth and St Saviours have met virtually to plan the transition of pupils.
	 As soon as it is known which teachers will be teaching which

pupils, this information will be shared with families.

• Leaders from the Yarmouth and Shalfleet federation have contacted the parents / carers and pupils of all of those due to join from All Saints in September.

3. Governors/school issues/concerns

- The Headteacher and Chair of governors of the Shalfleet and Yarmouth federation confirmed that the admissions process has been completed. All children from All Saints that required places in West Wight schools have places.
- For families where potentially a year R child is on the Yarmouth site and their sibling on the All Saints site in September, a place at the Yarmouth site will be offered. It should be noted that this is not compulsory and will remain parent / carer choice.
- The joint governing bodies will write a joint letter to parents and carers with all that they are able to share at this point regarding the detail of the September term start. It should be noted that the process of deciding staffing for September is still ongoing, as indeed it is for most schools at this point of the school year.
- A minibus is being looked into for September to enable the sharing of topics, trips and opportunities from September whilst the school is operating over two sites.
