

Asbestos permit terms and conditions

Asbestos is a hazardous substance which can cause serious health implications. It needs handling with care and must be disposed of safely.

- 1. A permit is required for the disposal of asbestos from a domestic residential property only; this cannot be used for the disposal of commercial asbestos.
- 2. Permits are valid for disposal at Lynnbottom Recycling Centre only.
- 3. Permits allow disposal of up to 60kg of asbestos free of charge per household in a six-month period.
- 4. If you have more than 60kg to dispose of, the first 60kg is free of charge and anything over that weight is chargeable. See our website for up-to-date fees.
- 5. Asbestos must be in unbroken sheets.
- 6. Asbestos must be double bagged, and cable tied or securely taped in heavy duty plastic.
