



1. Given the financial challenges the council faces, and inflation running at around 4 per cent, should we increase council tax or make even d eeper cuts to services?








4. Where do you think we should prioritise any remaining funds? Please rank your answers with 1 being the most important to you, and 10 being the least.






5. So far, we have asked you about your priorities for our day-to-day services. We also have to budget for one off projects. Which of the foll owing do you think the council should spend this budget on?





6. Which of the following options best describes how you think of yourself?








8. Which of these age groups do you belong to?

10. Please tell us if you consider yourself to have a disability, or a long-term illness, physical or mental health conditions?




