January 2019	IWALC presentation on Regulation 18 version of Draft IPS
5 July 2021 and 12 July 2021	All Member briefings on Draft IPS ahead of Cabinet
13 July 2021	<a href="#">Corporate Scrutiny Committee</a> receives Draft IPS and agrees to set up Task & Finish Group to report back by September 2021
15 July 2021	<a href="#">Cabinet</a> agreement to publish the Reg 18 plan
<b>30 July 2021 to 1 October 2021</b>	<b>Second regulation 18 version of the Draft IPS – public consultation ran for 9 weeks (statutory minimum is 6 weeks)</b>
15 December 2021	<a href="#">Corporate Scrutiny Committee</a> received Task & Finish Group report on Draft IPS (T&FG led by Cllr Spink)
17 December 2021	All Member update – focused on how Reg 18 consultation went, level of response (presentation slides circulated to All Members post event)
11 March 2022	All Member update– focused on housing number and supply issues (presentation slides circulated to All Members post event)
25 March 2022	All Member update – focused on emerging changes to Reg 19 version of IPS (presentation slides circulated to All Members post event)
12 July 2022	<a href="#">Corporate Scrutiny Committee</a> receives Reg 19 version of Draft IPS for review
6 Sept 2022	<a href="#">Corporate Scrutiny Committee</a> discuss Reg 19 version of the Draft IPS and a series of proposed changes
8 Sept 2022	<a href="#">Cabinet</a> agrees to send Reg 19 version of the Draft IPS to Full Council incorporating 4 recommendations made by Corporate Scrutiny Committee
5 October 2022	Reg 19 version of the Draft IPS was not supported at <a href="#">Extraordinary Full Council</a>
16 November 2022	A list of 10 objections to the Draft IPS were agreed at <a href="#">Full Council</a>
18 January 2023	Updated timeline for the Draft IPS agreed by <a href="#">Full Council</a>
19 April 2023	All Member briefing– focused on various routes and timetables available, including confirmation that next version of Draft IPS would pass through scrutiny, cabinet and full council later in 2023 (presentation slides circulated to All Members post event).
17 May 2023	Verbal update on Draft IPS given to <a href="#">Full Council</a>
1 August 2023	Standing Draft IPS item on <a href="#">forward plan</a> updated to reflect due dates to return to cabinet and full council

28 September 2023	All Member briefing – focused on national picture and next steps including confirmation next version of the Draft IPS would pass through scrutiny before cabinet & full council (presentation slides circulated to All Members post event).
5 October 2023	<a href="#">Policy &amp; Scrutiny Committee for Neighbourhoods and Regeneration</a> received an update report on the Draft IPS relating to timings and next steps
12 December 2023	<a href="#">Policy &amp; Scrutiny Committee for Neighbourhoods and Regeneration</a> to receive the Regulation 19 version of the Draft IPS for review ahead of Cabinet and Full Council in January 2023, including Schedule of changes and track changed version of the document
11 January 2024	Cabinet scheduled to receive the Regulation 19 version of the Draft IPS and any recommendations from scrutiny committee to consider whether to recommend to Full Council that the draft IPS should move to the next stage
17 January 2024	Full Council to receive a recommendation from Cabinet on the Draft IPS

**Should the Draft IPS be agreed at Full Council in January 2024, then the following statutory steps would take place under The Town and Country (Local Planning) (England) Regulation 2012 [the Regulations] and the Procedure Guide for Local Plan Examinations [the Procedures].:**

Regulation 19	A minimum 6 week period where the submission version of the IPS and accompanying evidence base is made available for public representation
Regulation 22	The submission version of the IPS, together with all of the supporting evidence base, and ALL comments duly made during the Regulation 19 period are formally submitted to the Secretary of State
Public examination	An independent inspector is appointed by the Planning Inspectorate to carry out an examination in public of the submission version of the IPS. Anyone making comments at the Regulation 19 stage will be able to request to appear at the hearing sessions. The decision on who appears is made solely by the appointed Planning Inspector.
