Hi There, I'm not sure if you can help me but I'm not sure where to go. I have a 17 year old son with ADHD. He has had a difficult year and is really struggling. I am trying to access him some support, as well as family support. We have a 2 year old daughter in the house and I'm terrified my sons behaviour will start to affect her. It is also having a detrimental impact on my marriage. My son wants to go into Public Services, which requires you to be off medication for 4 years prior to joining. This is where we are struggling, he needs to be on his medication but refuses. I just want the best for him, I want him to be happy and be able to manage his symptoms so he has a better quality of life. We moved down here last July, and stayed in stayed in with his father as we couldn't handle him anymore. This didn't work out well at all and his father kicked him out due to his behaviour, so he has recently moved back in with us here. I don't want to turn my back on him but we are struggling to cope and need some support but not sure what services we can access. Any help or advice would be hugely appreciated. Many thanks
