- 2. The four Local Cycling & Waking Infrastructure Plan Supplementary Planning Documents (SPDs) were adopted by the Isle of Wight Council at its Cabinet meeting on Thursday 13 February 2025. Following that decision being published and a 5 working day 'call in' period for the decision (as required by the council's Constitution), the SPDs came into force on Wednesday 26 February 2025.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Documents may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision. Any such application must be made promptly in any event no later than 3 months after the date on which the SPDs were adopted.
