Aims and objectives

Facilities

The Gouldings provides services and support 24 hours a day seven days a week throughout the year. There are 35 bedrooms, 25 single rooms and 10 double rooms. These are spread over three floors with all being serviced by both stairs and a lift.

Respite care can be regular or short-term, ranging from an overnight stay to longer periods.

Appetizing nutritionally balanced meals are provided. These are freshly prepared and cooked on site daily and reflects each individual's likes, dislikes and dietary needs.

A wide range of stimulating leisure activities including, outings, seasonal events, daily indoor entertainment and the occasional party.

There is also the Gouldings shop which offers a range of toiletries, confectionery and other useful items.

Personal services including, hairdressing and specialist foot care.
