Bouldnor Road, Yarmouth

PROBLEM:

 Cracking and undulation of carriageway due to coastal slope, with unstable geology and possible deficient road construction

- Heavy sheet pile wall over majority
- Soil nails to embankment
- Ongoing monitoring at site







Westhill Lane, Yarmouth

PROBLEM:

- Cracks and tears in the carriageway
- Pooling water turning to ice in cold

- Resurfacing
- Stabilisation works on the bend
- Extra surface drainage







Brook Chine, Military Road

PROBLEM:

- Chine is threatening carriageway
- Current lane closure

SOLUTION:

 Temporary bailey bridge on steel piles







Shippards Chine, Military Road

PROBLEM:

Threat from Chine

SOLUTION:

 Temporary bailey bridge on steel piles







Lower Road, Adgestone

PROBLEM:

 Edge of Carriageway unsafe due to failure of slope edge of road platform and evident

- Stabilise using soil nailed gabions
- Formalise and make permanent the current lane restriction
- Allow natural re-vegetation







The Terrace, Chale

PROBLEM:

- Cliff edge adjacent to the road
- Ongoing drainage issues

- Pump replacement
- Upgrading barrier system
- Ongoing maintenance







Old Access Road, Blackgang

PROBLEM:

- Bumps and cracks in the road
- Landslide embankment

- Erection of a more robust barrier
- Improved drainage
- Ongoing maintenance








The Undercliff, Ventnor

PROBLEM:

 Cracking and buckling of carriageway

- Ground anchors
- Soil nails
- Re-profiling of carriageways







La Falaise, Ventnor

PROBLEM:

- Water accumulation leading to weakening and erosion of the cliff at the path edge
- Loss of the path edge

- New drainage
- New handrail
- Realignment of the path







Gill's Cliff Road, Ventnor

PROBLEM:

- Tension cracking
- Rockfall on steps

- Geogrid reinforcement
- Resurfacing
- Repair of masonry







Newport Road, Ventnor

PROBLEM:

- Settlement causing carriageway buckling
- Damage to walls and footpaths

- Reinforced 'mattress'
- Carriageway reconstruction
- Resurfacing
- Provide steps to the 'old playground' area







Castle Court, Ventnor

PROBLEM:

 Buckling and cracking in the carriageway

- Geogrid
- Drainage reconstruction
- Resurfacing







Winter Gardens, Ventnor

PROBLEM:

Cracking in the footpath

SOLUTION:

Footway surfacing and renewal







Maintaining the highway

- Rural grass and hedge cutting
- Cleaning the streets and drains
- Keeping the Island moving during winter
- Providing an emergency response
- Tree care and landscaping
