**Buying your own home**— a talk will be given at 11.30a.m. by My Safe Home and you will be able to hear from someone who owns their own home. There will also be an opportunity to book personal appointments to talk this through in more detail.

Providers of supported living opportunities will be there and there will be opportunities throughout the day to speak to them direct and learn what they are able to offer
