ISLE OF WIGHT CORE STRATEGY (INCLUDING WASTE AND MINERALS) AND DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT ADOPTION STATEMENT

In accordance with the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, Regulation 24(2) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is hereby given that the Isle of Wight Council adopted the Isle of Wight Core Strategy (including Waste and Minerals) and Development Management Development Plan Document on 21 March 2012.

The Core Strategy sets out the vision, objectives and spatial strategy, and includes the core policies for guiding future development and land use to address the key planning issues affecting the Island up to 2027. It covers the whole of the Island.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy may make an application under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 to the High Court on grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. An application must be made no later than the end of the period of six weeks of the date of the adoption of this Core Strategy which is no later than 2 May 2012.
