8. What modifications do you think are needed to make the Island Planning Strategy legally compliant and/or sound?

Inclusion of adequate Solar power and suitably sized battery for every new build . That will add no more than ~£10,000 to every build. Less than 2-3% on an 'average' house. 10 panels minimum, 3.68 kWh Inverter and 5-10 kWh battery. That will give an approximate electric energy saving for an 'average' household of between £1,000 to £1600 per anum, depending on the cost of elecricity. The higher the cost of electricity, the bigger the savings. My current annual saving is ~ £1600 from a similar system.
