

Plasterboard permit terms and conditions

Plasterboard is a hazardous substance which can cause serious health and environmental implications. It needs handling with care and to be disposed of safely.

1. A permit is required for the disposal of plasterboard from a domestic residential property.

2. Permits are valid for disposal at Lynnbottom recycling centre only.

3. Permits allow disposal of up to 60kg of plasterboard free of charge per household in a six-month period.

4. If a resident has more than 60kg to dispose of, the first 60kg is free of charge and anything over that weight is chargeable. For current charges visit our website.

5. All plasterboard needs to be clean and free of any attachments, for example tiles.
