



What do I do with..?

Glass, plastics and metal

All these are recyclable here, whatever it says on the packaging!



- Plastic bottles
- Food containers
- Glass bottles
- Plastic bags
- Mixed metals
- Empty aerosols
- Shampoo bottles
- Tetrapak cartons
- Juice cartons
- Milk cartons
- Pringles tubes
- Glass jars
- Food film covering

Recyclables must be bagged before being placed into your green gull sack.



You can pop your recycling loose in your green wheelie bin, or into a clear or white bag then into the bin.

Please rinse bottles, tins, food containers and cartons so that they are empty and clean. P.S. You don't need to remove labels.



Filled your green wheelie bin or gull sack? Leave extra recyclables in a clear or white bag to the side.

Food waste

Paper and card

Put your excess paper and card in a clear sack to the side.

- Assorted paper
- Newspaper
- Envelopes
- Greetings cards
- Directories
- Magazines
- Shredded paper
- Cardboard containers
- Junk mail
- Leaflets
- Card



Textiles

You can use any bag to leave out textiles. Before you do, consider donating your unwanted clothes.

- Duvet cases
- Pillow cases
- Clothing
- Towels



Organic waste

Food waste can go in your kitchen caddy, but you might want to consider home composting organic waste for your garden.

- Garden waste
- Kitchen waste
- Leaves and cuttings
- Lawn trimmings
- Small pet bedding: sawdust, hay, straw



Non-recyclable household waste

You can pop your non-recycleables loose in your black wheelie bin, or into a black bag then into the bin.

- Nappies
- Sanitary items
- Cling film
- Bubble wrap
- Cold ash
- Pet food pouches
- Sweet wrappers
- Crisp packets
- Blister strips of pill packs
- Polystyrene
- Contaminated paper foil and cardboard, such as takeaway pizza boxes

Any household waste left outside of the bin or gull sack will not be taken.

Non-recyclables must be bagged before being placed into black gull sack.
