3. Schools Forum Powers and Responsibilities

Changes to Formula

Noted that proposed changes to the funding formula are sent out in the autumn term for consultation. Introduction of capping and scaling led to some confusion. Consultation documents should include clear explanations of pros and cons for changes, possible options and examples.

Consultation info is needed as early as possible, to allow time for full consideration and digestion of the impact on school to enable a fully informed response.
