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### What is the Short Breaks programme?

With the support of local businesses, the Isle of Wight Council's Short Breaks team has curated lots of fun activities specifically for young people on the Isle of Wight, with disabilities and/or additional needs. If you want to participate and are eligible (see below) - you will need to complete a simple form to take part.

## Can I do Short Breaks activities?

If you answer 'yes' to the following you are eligible to join in Short Breaks activities.

- I am eighteen years old or younger.
- I have a disability and/or additional need that means I need support to join in leisure and recreational activities.
- I live on the lovely Isle of Wight and/or go to school here.

#### Are there any other benefits?

Yes, if you are eligible for Short Breaks, you and your family can also use the caravan at Shanklin, which is equipped for people with disabilities. Find out more on page twenty.

## Who are the young inspectors?

The young inspectors are young people who use the services of Short Breaks. Any service user can apply to be a young inspector.

#### What do the young inspectors do?

The young inspectors work together to check out and rate the activities in this programme. They do this by joining in, watching how others participate and filling out a questionnaire with their findings. There is help to do this - and there is also a reward! For each event or activity they inspect they receive a £5 voucher stamp, which will be awarded to them at the young inspectors party at the end of the year.

## How do young inspectors help?

It's important that the voices and opinions of young people are listened to. The inspectors' feedback is used to improve the Short Breaks service and help others choose which activities they want to do.

# About young inspectors star ratings

If an activity has been inspected by the young inspectors then it will have a star rating; this will be shown on the activity page as a magnifying glass with one, two or three stars, plus the year it was rated. If there is no rating, it means that an inspection is due to happen.

### How can I become a young inspector?

If you are aged between four- and eighteenyears-old you may be able to join the young inspectors skilled workforce.




