POLICE, FACTORIES, ETC (MISCELLANEOUS) ACT, SECTION 6
PERMIT FOR STREET COLLECTION

POLICY

DATED 24 OCTOBER 1995

- (1) That separate collections be permitted in the following areas: Cowes; Freshwater (including Totland and Yarmouth); Newport; Ryde; Sandown; Shanklin and Ventnor.
- (2) That, subject to (3) below, only one organisation be permitted to conduct a street collection in any year, in any one of the above areas on not more than one day in any week.
- (3) That additional street collections in any week be permitted only in respect of special events, such as carnivals, Cowes Week, and during December.
- (4) That any unsuccessful applicant be advised of the availability of the Charity Stall at Newport Market, if this facility still exists.
- (5) That permits will not be granted to any organisation which has not submitted a statement of income and expenditure for a previous street collection.

The following condition was added following the resolution made by the Public Protection Committee on 7 August 1997.

- (6) THAT the Chairman of the Council be authorised to nominate three other days in any one year when a charity, of his or her choice, can be issued with a street collection permit for each day subject to any charity having a maximum of 3 days.
