1. Introduction

- 1.1. In 2017 a new duty was placed on local planning authorities to prepare, maintain and publish a register of previously developed land (brownfield land) which is suitable for residential development. The register must be published by 31 December 2017 and reviewed at least once each year.
- 1.2. The register, known as the Brownfield Land Register comprises a standard set of information, prescribed by the Government that will be kept up-to-date, and made publicly available. The purpose of the register is to provide certainty for developers and communities and encourage investment in local areas. The registers will then be used to monitor the Government's commitment to the delivery of brownfield sites.
- 1.3. The register must be kept in two parts:
 - Part 1 will include all sites which meet the definition of previously developed land, and
 - Are 0.25 hectares or more in size or capable of accommodating at least 5 dwellings, and

Meet the Government's criteria, set out in paragraph (1) of Regulation 4¹ setting out that sites must be suitable, available and achievable for residential development.

- 1.4. Entry onto Part 1 of the register does not guarantee that this site will progress onto Part 2 of the register or receive planning permission.
- 1.5. Part 2 allows us to select sites from Part 1 and grant Permission in Principle (PIP) for housing-led development, after undertaking necessary requirements for publicity, notification and consultation. More information can be found in the <u>National Planning Practice Guidance</u>.

2. Isle of Wight's Brownfield Land Register

- 2.1 A call for potential brownfield sites was launched by the Council on 20 October 2017 and closed 4 December 2017. As a result council received a number of sites for potential inclusion.
- 2.2 As stated above all sites need to meet certain criteria which the Council will need to have regard to.
- 2.3 In assessing suitability the Council will also consider:
 - the development plan;
 - national policies and advice;

any guidance issued by the Secretary of State.

This also includes development plan documents, the London Plan and Spatial Development Strategies any relevant neighbourhood plans, the National Planning Policy Framework, Planning Practice Guidance, any other guidance published by the Secretary of State including Strategic Environmental Assessments, Environmental Impact Assessments and Habitat Regulation Assessments (where/when appropriate) and any other relevant statutory requirements and guidance.


- 2.4 At this time we have not selected sites for Part 2 stage. We have instead concentrated on publishing Part 1 in time to meet the 31st December 2017 deadline and will consider Part 2 in due course.
- 2.5 As such our register comprises of a number of the following:
 - Brownfield sites that have been granted planning permission and are either under construction (with residential units still to be completed) or not started.
 - Those brownfield sites that have been put forward by landowners, developers, agents and others that have been assessed by the Council and meet the criteria set out in paragraph (1) of Regulation 4.
- 2.6 Due to the number of sites put forward following the Council's 'call for sites', not all have been able to be fully assessed in line with the required criteria within the timeframe. Therefore the council is likely to undertake an early review of the Register.


3. Brownfield Land Register Maps





















BFR047 SPA site, Shanklin Esplanade







BFR050 23, Carter Street, Sandown


