### **Purpose:**

Under the direction of the Assistant Headteacher - to lead support for students identified with emotional literacy needs, or speech and language needs

#### Key tasks and responsibilities:

- Attend training days and group supervision sessions led by an Educational Psychology Service/Local Authority Speech and Language team
- Plan and deliver individualised programmes of individual and small group support for identified students across the federation
- Implement clear entry and exit criteria and record assessment data to support this
- Write succinct session plans and add subsequent evaluative comment
- Liaise with teachers and other support assistants about the needs and progress of students receiving support amend student profiles to support this
- Share knowledge and ideas from training/supervision sessions with other federation staff as appropriate
- Liaise with parents in line with school policy
- Undertake training by the SENDCO to use diagnostic tools (such as Boxall Profile, British Vocabulary Picture Test, Lucid LASS)
